What is a BID?

A Business Improvement District (BID) enables groups of businesses to commission projects that will lead to improvements in their local trading environment, funded through an additional levy charged through the business rates system.

The funding raised from the levy is ring fenced and held locally by an accountable body (Groundwork in the case of Winsford Industrial Estate) and invested in added value projects and services. The projects and services are all commissioned and delivered under the governance and direction of the Winsford Industrial Estate business community. The funds raised cannot be used to support or pay for services that are a statutory obligation of the public sector.

The Winsford 1-5 Business Improvement District is a partnership between the businesses on the industrial estate, Cheshire West and Chester Council, Groundwork and a range of partner organisations.

Since 2004, when the legislation to enable BIDs was introduced, more than 300 BIDs have been approved by companies across the UK.

What can the BID do for your business?

The Winsford 1-5 Business Improvement District is broken down in to three themes, with a range of services and projects designed to benefit businesses focused within each one:

Theme One: A Secure and Safe Trading Environment

Theme Two: Green and Clean

Theme Three: A Co-ordinated and Supported Business Community

Theme One: A Secure and Safe Trading Environment

Rapid Text Service

Should you spot something suspicious that you want to warn other businesses on Winsford Industrial Estate about, the BID offers the use of a dedicated Rapid Text Service.

The Rapid Text Service enables organisations to transfer 'real time' information, warnings and messages to key employees across Winsford Industrial Estate, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

To use the service, simply ring 01606 866 826 and report what you wish to be shared. A text will then immediately be sent out to all businesses across Winsford Industrial Estate that are registered to the system.

CCTV and **ANPR Cameras**

The Winsford 1-5 BID has funded two ANPR (Auto Number Plate Recognition) cameras at both ends of Road One on the estate to log every car number plate that passes through either entrance, as well as the dedicated five camera CCTV system across the estate. This ensures that security is at the highest level on the estate. In the event that you fall foul of a crime on Winsford Industrial Estate, you can request permission for CCTV footage to be sent to the police as part of the investigation - please ring 01606 **723175** or email **Winsford1-5**@ groundworkcheshire.org.uk

How do I make a request for CCTV?

- Give details of date. approximate time and location of the crime. A map with the precise location circled of where the incident occurred is often useful.
- Provide a brief description of the offence, eg. Anti-social behaviour, burglary, vehicle related crime, theft and damage, traffic offences and incidents.
- Provide a police crime reference number, as well as the name and contact details of the police officer that is handling the case. The police station that the footage needs to be delivered to is also useful.

What happens to my request once received?

- Once all details are received by the BID Team, a formal request to the CCTV monitoring station is made.
- Images are downloaded to DVD and sent directly to the named contact at Cheshire Police (supplied in the data request) to be reviewed.
- Only requests that relate to the prevention and detection of crime will be processed and all images will be sent directly to Cheshire Police.









Mobile Security Patrols

Mobile security patrols funded by the BID are conducted by Alpha Omega Security Services over the Bank Holiday weekends, Easter weekend and over the Christmas and New Year period to ensure Winsford Industrial Estate remains as secure as possible over these periods. If a security risk is identified, mobile security guards can be summoned immediately until no longer needed.

Selecta DNA Kits

SelectaDNA forensic property marking kits are distributed to all new companies on the estate, with the kits aiming to protect the assets and belongings of businesses and ensuring the police can link criminals to the crime scene and secure a conviction.

The kits mean businesses can mark their most valuable assets with a solution made up of unique DNA code and microdots that is only visible under UV light. This combination instantly identifies the property as belonging to your company or institution, making resale on the black market next to impossible. Furthermore it links criminals directly to their crime - so your assets are not nearly as attractive to thieves as they might have been. By displaying the warning signs, posters and stickers included in the kit, thieves will know to keep away.

Keyholding Service

The Winsford 1-5 BID offers a free Key Holding Service provided by Alpha Omega for Winsford Industrial Estate businesses. If you would like to take advantage of this service, all you need to do is register with Alpha Omega and provide your contact details (contact name, phone number, company name and company address). Grounds Maintenance

The Winsford 1-5 BID has an ongoing landscape maintenance scheme with a local company to ensure the Estate is kept in good condition visually. The BID also utilises the local Community Payback scheme to conduct various litter picks and general grounds cleansing across

the estate. General grounds maintenance, maintenance of the poles, banners, signs and Cheshire Fencing is all undertaken as well as the seating areas across the estate. Signage is also washed and given a deep cleanse on a regular basis.

Training Courses and Seminars

All companies based on Winsford Industrial Estate are entitled to attend one of the many BID funded training courses that we run throughout the year. The courses are FREE OF CHARGE to any employee who wishes to attend, as they are all funded and delivered through the BID.

Our courses are designed to cover as wide a variety of topics as possible, ranging from Health & Safety to Fire Marshal Training or First Aid at Work and Mental Health First Aid - all important aspects in keeping your work environment safe and running as smoothly as possible.

Accredited courses include:

- 3 Day First Aid at Work
- 1 Day Emergency First Aid at Work
- Level 3 Mental Health First Aid in the Workplace
- Level 2 Award in Health & Safety in the Workplace
- Principles of Manual Handling
- Principles of COSHH
- Principles of Risk Assessment
- Fire Marshal Training

Other topics include:

- Fire Risk Assessment
- Asbestos Awareness training

The BID has also held a number of educational seminars and workshops including Excel Spreadsheet training, Presentation Skills training, as well as Employment Law workshops. If a topic is not covered that you are wishing to train an employee up in, then please do let us know and we will look in to hosting it as part of the schedule.

The Winsford 1-5 BID also funds Fork Lift Truck refresher training in both Reach and Counterbalance for employees on the estate. If you are wishing to do a full Fork Lift Truck training course, then the BID can offer a contribution that is equal to the cost of what a refresher course would be. Banksman Training and Abrasive Wheel Training is also on offer for those that require it.
