### Tiger Trailers partners up with delivery firm Evri

E vri, the biggest dedicated parcel carrier in the UK and the new name for Hermes, has turned to Tiger Trailers in order to add to its fast-growing fleet of delivery vehicles.

Sourced in time to support the opening of its largest delivery hub in Europe, Evri has welcomed 168 articulated box vans from Tiger as the delivery company gets ready to sort up to 3 million parcels every day going into the festive season.

Tiger's sales, design and engineering teams worked closely with Evri to ensure that its new 4.6-metre-high trailers are manufactured to bespoke specifications and a high quality and incorporate various Tiger specific design components for strength and durability.

To keep business and domestic customers' parcels secure in transit between Evri distribution centres, a two-row, surface-mounted load securing system has also been fitted internally, along with a rear net and lashing rings. It's not the first time that Tiger Trailers have worked in partnership with Evri having manufactured 200 twin-axle box van trailers for Hermes in 2015. The companies also share a focus on environmental sustainability by means of solar panels and tree planting in conjunction with their ambition to aid job creation for their local areas.

Speaking about this latest order, the Sales Director at Tiger Trailers, Darren Holland, commented: "Working alongside David and the Evri team has been great and we are really pleased with the finished product. The fact that we can offer a full package has meant that we have designed, manufactured and also provided the leasing for these trailers via Tiger Finance."
